On April 15, 2010 the Consulate General of the Federal Republic of Germany invited to a piano concert of German pianist Evelyn Ulex to celebrate 200 Years Robert Schumann (1810-2010) at Steinway Piano Gallery in Coral Gables



Evelyn Ulex is a very talented pianist born in Berlin, Germany. At the age of ten, she won the national "Festival of Young Talent" competition in Dresden and later received top medals in the J.S. Bach competition in Leipzig, Germany. She was placed in the prestigious Special School for Music in Berlin and continued her studies at the Hanns Eisler University, graduated from the UdK, and pursued further studies with Boris Bloch at the Folkwang Hochschule, where she received her artist diploma. She has performed as a soloist and with orchestras and intensively in chamber music concerts throughout Europe and the Americas



To this special celebration of 200 Years Robert Schumann (1810-2010) in Miami, on April 15, 2010 Ms. Ulex enchanted the audience with a great program including Schumann Romanze op.28/1, Faschingschwank aus Wien op.26 and Kinderszenen and adding feelings, thoughts and events from Schumann related to the music pieces she performed with great talent.
